Comments on average salary calculation (optional):"In budget year 2020, we employed 4.5 teachers. One of our teachers was a lead teacher with years of experience making a salary of \$60,000. For budget year 2021, he is now employed as our principal and we are in the process of hiring a teacher with many years less experience at a salary that is \$17,000/year less than the lead teacher turn principal. As a result, our average salary has been reduced a great deal. However, we provided a 5% increase for each of our teachers as well as to our base salary scale. This 5% increase results in a total of a 20% increase in our salaries since FY18.
